PATENTS -- We have all full patents since 1940, many back to 1883, and Official Gazette coverage from 1872 to present. Patents from 1964 forward are on microfilm. Ask at the Reference Desk for patent information. MAPS-- and their related fields of study may be found in the Map And Geographic Information Center (MAGIC) on LL2. MICROFORMS-- Some journals and many technical reports are in a micro-format; most are in the Microforms Area, west wing of LL1.
