Using the CSEL Home Page as a Doorway to Science & Engineering Information

A broad introduction to researching scientific and technical information on-line (and sometimes in print), this one hour session provides a hands-on opportunity to learn about resources provided through the Centennial Science and Engineering Library. Classes are tailored to the individual research needs of attendees but may include such topics as finding cited references, using electronic indices such as SciSearch and INSPEC to find appropriate information, accessing electronic journals, and surfing the Web. This class is recommended for undergraduates, graduate students, staff, and faculty.

Classmate Plus Training

Classmate Plus is offered to students in support of their academic work through Dialog's 350 databases. Key databases include BIOSIS, Life Sciences Collection, Chemical Abstracts, MEDLINE, Zoological Record, GeoRef, INSPEC, and others. Advantages include the ability to search several databases simultaneously and the ability to eliminate duplicate references. A fee of \$18/hour pro-rated by the minute is charged.
