Centennial Science & Engineering Library Mural Call for Submissions

<u>Centennial Science & Engineering Library</u> (CSEL) invites all student artists connected to UNM to submit mural proposals for a hallway in the library to create a more welcoming space. The Mural Committee (comprised of Learning Services, CSEL Operations Manager, and a member of the art department) will select a winner and the final design will be subject to approval by the College administration. The selected artist will paint the mural in the summer of 2023. This project is for an impermanent mural, with a lifetime of three to five years. The mural will be documented (artist's notes, photographs, etc.) prior to elimination.

Space: This hallway is in the subbasement of CSEL with no natural light available. The hallway space is 30 feet long. We would like the mural to use a good amount of that space, but we are open to alternatives (for instance part of the mural spilling out of the hallway into the main portion). We encourage applicants to visit the space in person (please remember to <u>bring your Lobocard or an ID for entry</u>).



Themes: We'd like this mural to bring the outside in by highlighting New Mexico landscapes, nature, and/or outdoors at any scale in any artistic style. *Note*: artist(s) will not be able to use spray paint.

Eligibility: This call is open to all currently enrolled UNM students. An individual student or a team (all members must be currently enrolled UNM students) may submit a proposal.

Call dates: December 12, 2022 to February 24, 2023 (11:59pm)

Calendar:

- December 12, 2022 Call for submissions opens
- February 24, 2023 Deadline for submission(s)
- March 24, 2023 Selected mural announced
- May-July 2023 Mural painted
- August 1. 2023 Mural finished
- August Mural unveiling ceremony

Selection Process: The selection committee will review each submission based on the themes above, artist statement, and artistic quality.

Budget:

- Selected artist (or team) will receive a \$2000 stipend
- Materials (e.g. paint, brushes, rollers) of approximately \$1000

- *Image attachments* (only JPG images of 180-300 dpi; min 1105 x 736; max 1838 x 1238)
 - Sample image. Sample must not be computer generated. The sample needs to be a hand drawing (digital sketch tools like Procreate or Illustrator are fine) or painting.
 - Images of previous work by artist(s) up to 5 images
- Multiple submissions are allowed.
